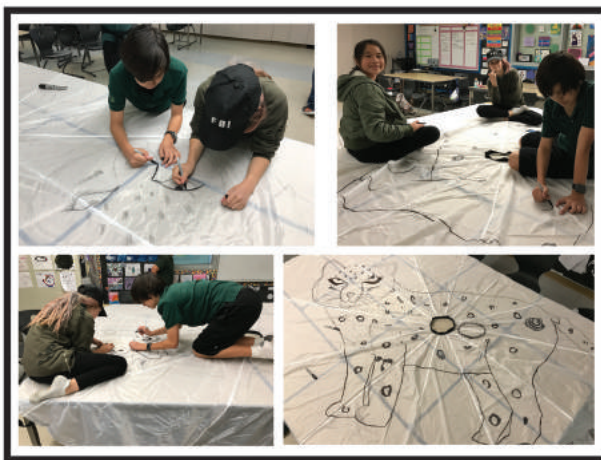

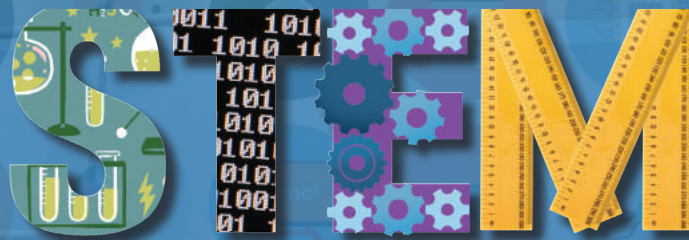
On July 21, 2018, Parachutes for the Planet and ThisIsZeroHour.org are rallying the youth of the world to demand climate action and a sustainable future.
