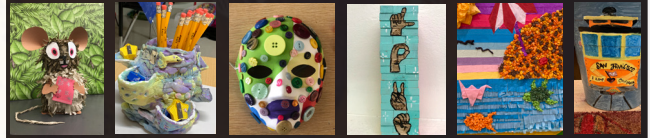

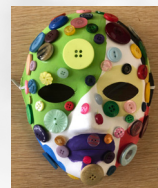

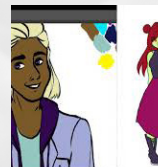
December Mystery

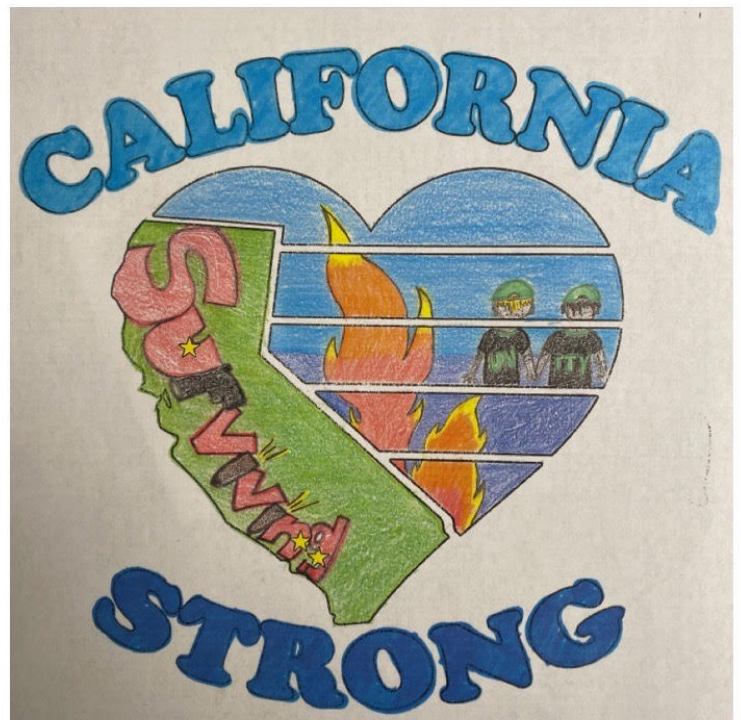

Celebrating the year of the rat, the students, who are all year of the rat wanted to pay homage to Chinese New Year.

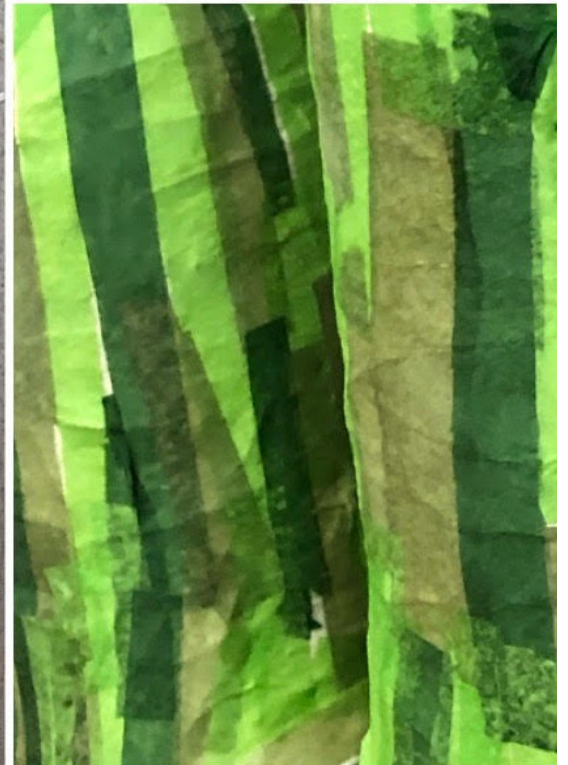

Students learned about Day of the Dead and celebrated by creating their own sugar skull.

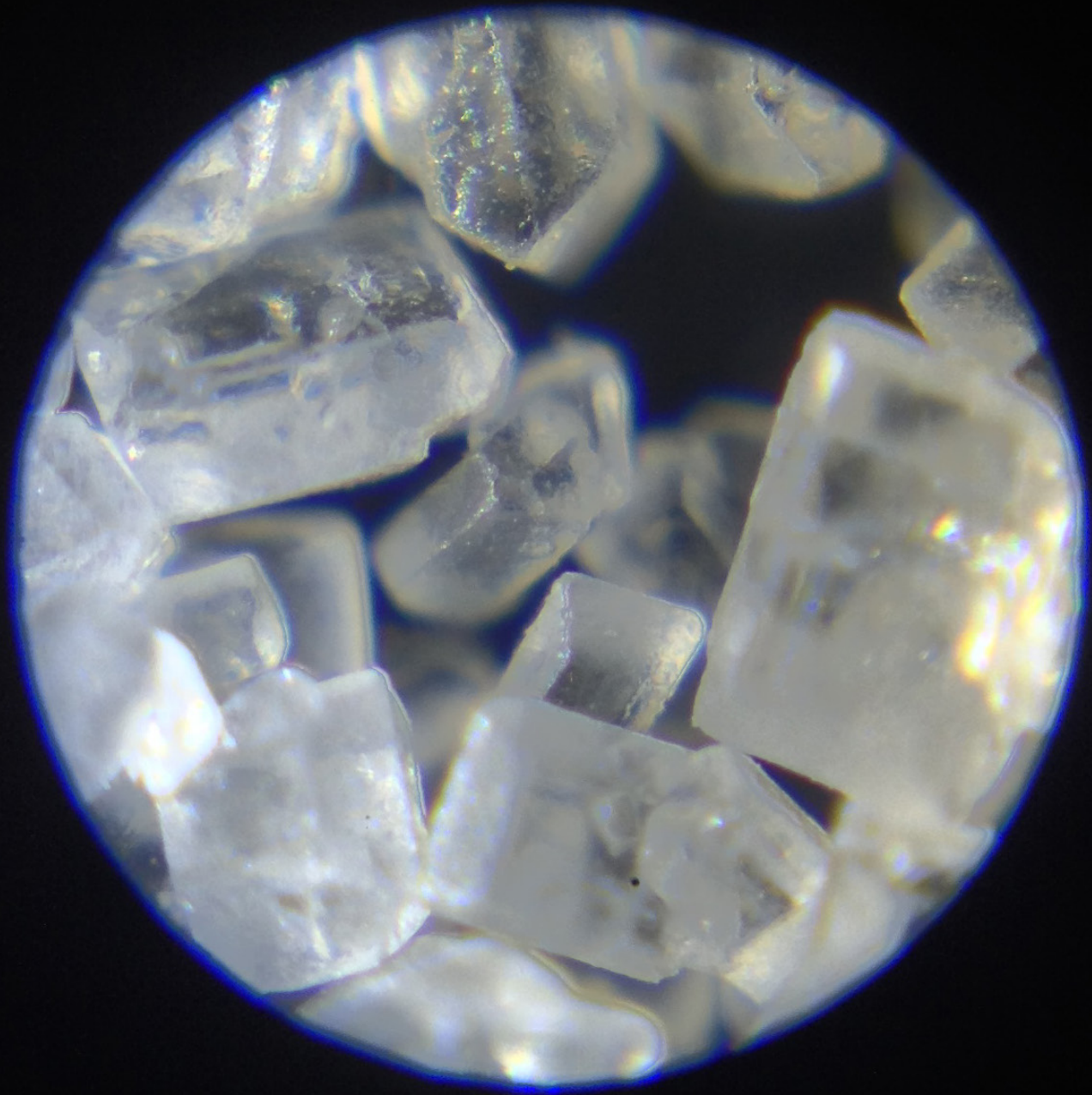

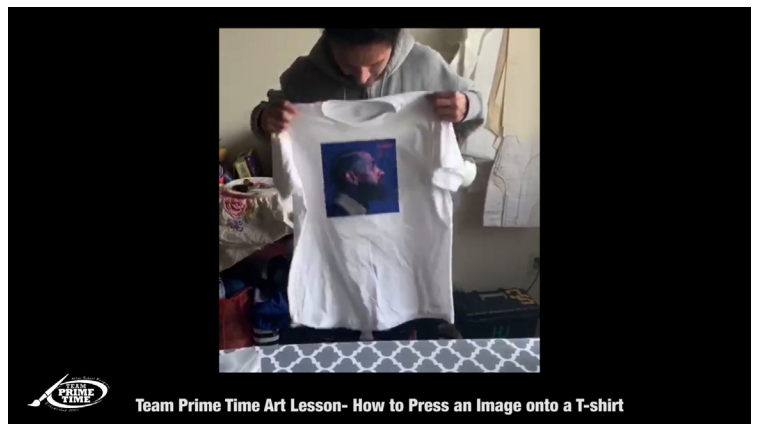
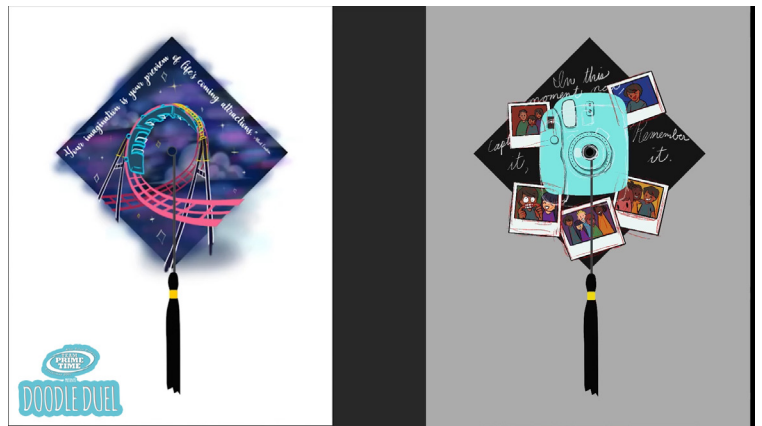
Mystery Art Box Challenges
